What's discontinued and modified?

Document/Meeting Workspace/Group Work/Personalization Site Templates

Reason: Use Team Sites, Lync, OneNote and My Site instead

Organization Profiles

Reason: SharePoint revolves around users and groups

Inserting Barcodes and Labels from Office

Reason: Adoption and not meeting RM expectations

PowerPoint Broadcast from SharePoint

Reason: Use Lync instead

Web Analytics

Reason: Performance and use new search analytics instead

What's discontinued and modified? cont'd

RSS feed of Search Results

Reason: Use search alerts and SharePoint RSS instead

Custom Help

Reason: Use Wikis instead

Visio Pivot Diagrams based on a SharePoint Task list

Reason: Assigned to field now Visio unsupported multi-value field

Visual Upgrade

Reason: Use deferred site collection upgrade instead

Chart Web Part and Status Indicators

Reason: Use Excel Services instead

What's discontinued and modified? cont'd

SharePoint Designer "Design View"

- Impacts:
 - Creating full-featured Data view Web Parts (DVWPs)
 - No more Data form web parts to connect to lists, libraries, databases or web services
 - Workflow Initiation/association forms can't be modified
 - Simple page formatting changes won't be possible
 - Unable to Preview your changes
 - Custom filtering using XSLT
 - Drop web parts easily into web part zones
 - Master page and page view editing
 - Only code view in Wiki Pages, Site Pages, List View pages, Web Part Pages
 - No conditional formatting, web part connections

Reason: No great reason here in my opinion! MS says:

- Design View is not up to date with IE
- Code View used more than Design View
- Design View can't support new HTML5 and CSS



Developer Dashboard



- Huge improvement to its predecessor for Developer and Administrator debugging
- No longer a page control which only shows info about current request but now a separate window which shows you ALL requests since you started developer dashboard session!
- Has ULSViewer elements in it
- See server info, SQL, Service Calls, ULS and SPRequests all from this view in a nice tabbed view

Development Environment for your Apps

- On Premises Physical or Virtual Server(s)
 - Be aware of the new <u>hardware and software requirements</u> for SharePoint 2013!
 - Ensure you have at least 10GB RAM or you will get Memory related errors!
 - Not allowed on Windows 7 (or 8) anymore, need Windows Server 2008 R2 SP1 or Windows Server 2012
- Cloud based
 - CloudShare
 - Amazon Web Services EC2
 - Windows Azure Virtual Machines
- Office 365 Preview
 - Office 365 with SharePoint 2013 Preview
 - SharePoint 2013 Developer Site



Callout feature



- New callout feature in place of the Edit Control Block menu
- Nice preview of the document you are interested in
- Extra information such as ability to open, share and take some extra actions.
- Extended capabilities of Callout feature in search
- Get ability to embed previews into your discussions and such
- This was created to support the new mobile and tablet world

SkyDrive Pro



- SkyDrive Pro is like SharePoint 2010 Workspace but not necessarily a replacement.
- SkyDrive Pro can run in parallel with the consumer version of SkyDrive and can give you access to your SharePoint related documents when you're offline and automatically sync updates to the SharePoint server when you go back online.
- Big difference is the that it will have the 'Pro' features of SharePoint such as social networking, collaboration, search, metadata, workflow and compliance.

Drag and Drop



 Using Windows Explorer, you can now drag and drop documents into SharePoint directly

Works across modern browsers!

Bulk Editing Items and Column Quick Edit



- You can now edit list items on the list itself instead of being forced to go to a list item edit page.
- One click mechanism that lets you edit the list item like a row in Excel.
- Easily add new list columns to a list using the new Quick Edit capability

Social Networking in

Newsfeeds and Microblogging



- My Site has been reorganized into three distinct hubs: Newsfeed, SkyDrive, and Sites
- Personal and public newsfeeds, where you can start conversations, see activities such as document, tagging, person or site activities
- Integration with Microblogging which allows anyone the ability to post to a private or public newsfeed where everyone (or people you identify) can view, "like", and respond to posts

Document and Site Sharing



- Easily share your site and documents with your colleagues
- New "Share" focus in SharePoint 2013
- "SkyDrive Pro" where you can store personal or shared documents, collaborate on documents with your colleagues and follow documents of interest
- New SharePoint folder that is synced with your SharePoint server on your desktop where it syncs SkyDrive pro and site document libraries
- Can easily Share your SkyDrive Pro documents from your desktop

Central Sites and Tasks Pages



- A place to keep track of all of your owned sites and sites you would like to follow across your SharePoint environment.
- A place where you can centrally keep track of all of your active, completed, or overdue tasks in all of your SharePoint sites. If you are integrated with Exchange, you can see all of your Outlook tasks here as well!

Web Content Authoring in

Retained Pasted Text Formatting



 All Page Editor Web Parts, Content Editor Web Parts, and HTML field controls can now retain all pasted text formatting when copying content from Microsoft Word

Easy Menu Customization



- Drag and Drop and On Page Customization of Current and Global Navigation Menus
- Customize global and current navigation menus by dragging menu items directly from page and edit the links on the page instead of going to a navigation settings page

New Video Content Type



- New video content type adds simplified upload process
- Includes thumbnail previews
- Allow you to pick a frame from within the video to use as the thumbnail preview image
- Can embed from online sources like YouTube.
- Video renditions is new capability where you can have renditions of videos spanning different resolutions, encoding formats, and modified video content and SharePoint can manage which encoding is played depending on browser and device.

Web Content Management in

Cross Search Publishing and Product Catalogs

- Allows you to store and maintain content in various internal or authoring site collections and display it in your publishing or other site collections (i.e. your anonymous web site).
- All changes are displayed in your target site collection via search technology in conjunction with the Content By Search Web Part (next section) to retrieve content from source site collection.
- There is a Cross-Site Collection Publishing feature that needs to be enabled and libraries and lists have to be enabled as catalogs before the content can be reused in other site collections.
- There is also a new Product Catalog Site Collection which is designed to author, store and maintain data that is used in a catalog scenario.

Content By Search Web Part



- Instead of being tied to a site collection using the Content By Query Web Part, there is a new very powerful Content By Search Web Part that you leverages search and the index to perform customized searches based on various settings and refiners.
- This Content By Search Web Part can span across site collections and web applications and is not tied to one site collection.
- Furthermore, the view that is rendered is totally customizable.

New Community and Project Site Template



- Community Sites expand on discussion boards be enabling site members a more formal area to share, discuss, learn, categorize and reward in an easy and interactive fashion.
- Project sites are a new collaboration site template where teams can to access, share relevant data, documents, and communication. The new Project Site has a Visual timeline of the project's tasks and can be connected to Exchange to centrally manage Email on the site.







- SharePoint Server 2013 includes support for the development, installation, management, and use of apps.
- An app is a small-scale, stand-alone program that solves a specific end-user need.
- End users can discover and download apps from the SharePoint Store, or from their organization's Internal App Directory.

Site Customization in

Design Manager



- Enables a step-by-step approach for creating design assets that you can use to brand sites.
- Upload design assets—images, HTML, CSS, and so on
- Create your master pages and page layouts from your own HTML
- You can preview how your design looks either in a client-side code editor or on the server as you are designing it
- Edit your master page and page layouts from any HTML editor

Theme Gallery



- New theming experience that guides you through a quick process to change the look of your site and make it unique.
- Can choose among multiple options of color, font, site layout
- Use your own background images and the tool will automatically center and water mark it
- Can preview and try it out before accepting

Enterprise Content Management in


Discovery, Content Preservation and Case Management

- Discovery Center site template allows ability to conduct searches, place content on hold in cases of litigation, investigations, etc...
- Gives ability to export content for offline use and Exchange integration
- Discovery Download Manager add-on to export eDiscovery searches in offline review tool using industry standard formats and allow exports of docs, lists, pages, and Exchange objects such as tasks, contacts, and email messages
- Using Discovery site template, content that is placed on hold can be preserved while still allowing users to modify it.
- Even, if user modifies content or even deletes it, original, preserved version is still available.


New BI Site, OData access from Excel, Mobile Access


- New Business Intelligence site

- Connect external data using OData providers in SharePoint or Office 365.




Advanced BI capabilities in Excel and Excel Services


- Drill into data displayed in Excel Services reports
